Closed or Reduced Hours at Fingerprinting Locations

Yesterday, PAR facilitated a call between PAR members and staff, senior officials of the US Administration for Community Living (ACL), the Pennsylvania Department of Human Services (DHS), and the Office of Developmental Programs (ODP) to discuss the fingerprinting issues ID/A providers and other healthcare providers across the Commonwealth are experiencing. Providers are reporting that fingerprinting service locations are either closed or have significantly reduced office hours. There are major concerns that this will prevent or significantly slow the ability to hire new staff.

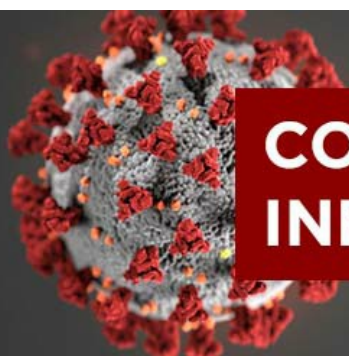
