Medicaid is a federal match program administered under the Centers for Medicaid and Medicare Services (CMS). CMS is part of the Department of Health and Human Services. Medicaid services are funded through state and federal funding. The state is reimbursed at a predetermined percentage for all eligible Medicaid services. In Pennsylvania, the federal match is approximately 51%. This means the federal government reimburses Pennsylvania about 51 cents for every dollar PA spends on eligible Medicaid services.

Currently, 3.6 million Pennsylvanians (about 23%) receive Medicaid services (2.2 million adults and 1.4 million children).
